Background - Construction Program

- NIH Extramural Construction Program requires:
 - 1) Construction Authority
 - 2) Construction Appropriation
- ORIP has Construction Authority
 - **★** ORIP can manage NIH extramural construction programs: issue FOAs, issue awards (if funding is available)
 - **★** Since its creation in 2011, ORIP has been the only NIH unit that issued FOAs and managed extramural construction programs



Background - Construction Program

Construction appropriations (since 2011):

- Special initiatives funded by congressional acts:
 - **★ Hurricane Sandy Disaster Relief**
 - * Hurricane Maria, Harvey & Irene Relief
- OAR annual budget appropriation
- FY 2019 \$50M Congressional appropriation



OAR - ORIP Initiatives

- OAR ORIP Collaborative Initiatives:
- **★ Four FOAs published in FYs 2013, 2017, 2018, and 2019**
 - ▶ 7 awards; cumulative budget \$16.2M
 - ► FY2019:

September 2019 Council Available budget: up to \$8M



Special Congressional Acts

- Special Initiatives
- **★** Two FOAs published in FYs 2014 and 2019
 - ► FY 2014: 2 Awards; cumulative budget: \$49M
 - ► FY2019
 May 2019 Council
 Available budget: up to \$15M



Most Recent Appropriation

- FY 2019 Congressional appropriation
 - **★ PAR19-128: Biomedical Research Facilities**Pending, September 2019 Council
 Available budget \$50M
