GOALS OF S10 PROGRAMS

- To fund grants to purchase expensive instruments to support & enhance research of NIH-funded Investigators
- Instruments are to be used on sharedbasis
- Commercially available instrumentation



HEI PROGRAM

- Program started in 2002
- > Specialized new generation instruments
- ➤ Awards: \$750K \$2M
- Receipt Date: biannually
- > Funding over 2 FYs




HEI PROGRAM

- > FY2002 FY2013
 - 194 awards
 - Total budget: \$295M (\$24.5M / year)
- > FY2014
 - 16 awards
 - Budget: \$24.5M



HEI: % REQUESTS & AWARDS in FY 02-13



CURRENT HEI PROGRAM

- > Timeline
 - Due date: September 2013
 - Review: January-February 2014
 - Council: May/June 2014
 - Funding cycle: FY2014 (year 1):
 Summer 2014
 - Funding cycle: FY2015 (year 2):
 Fall 2014 Summer 2015

HEI: ANNUAL RECEIPT DATE?

- Ramifications:
 - Every year, award the same # of grants
 - Over 2 years, award the same # of grants
 - However, somewhat different grants may be awarded



HEI: ANNUAL RECEIPT DATE?

- Changes that are unknown:
 - Number of applications
 - Resubmission rate
