An Informatics, Coordination, and Service Center (ICSC) located at University of California at Davis provides informatics and coordinating services to support the function of the MMRRC Consortium





MMRRC Progress and Impacts Reported by ICSC


The collection consists of 44,964 unique mutant alleles (submissions include live mice, frozen germplasm, or ESCs).
