


Excel Tip: Opening .tsv or .csv files without foreign characters being replaced with numbers and symbols

1. Open an Excel workbook. The .tsv or .csv file will open as a new sheet in that workbook.






3. Click on the button From Text/CSV on the top left corner



4. Find the file you'd like to open. The default setting will allow you to visualize .csv files but in order to view .tsv files, you will have to adjust the drop-down button to "All Files"



5. Click *Import*. On the pop-up screen, click on the drop-down arrow in *File Origin*, and choose "65001: Unicode (UTF-8)". Click *Load*. The file will open as a new sheet.
