



National Institutes of Health Tribal Consultation Advisory Committee Nominations for New Members Requested

The National Institutes of Health (NIH) Tribal Consultation Advisory Committee (TCAC) was established in 2015 to provide a venue wherein tribal representatives and NIH staff can exchange information about NIH research policies and program priorities. As an advisory committee, the NIHTCAC provides recommendations on the development of relevant NIH policies, programs, and priorities.

Vacancies open for nomination include:

- Albuquerque Area (Delegate and Alternate)
- Billings Area (Delegate and Alternate)
- California Area (Delegate and Alternate)
- Oklahoma Area (Alternate)
- Phoenix Area (Delegate and Alternate)
- National At-Large Member (2 Delegates and 3 Alternates)

Each area representative must be an elected official or a tribal employee, who is designated to act on behalf of a tribal leader. Each national at-large representative must be an elected official or designated representative who is qualified to represent the views of tribes from a national collective perspective.

Nominations should be submitted no later than **October 28, 2016**.
